1. Discussed structure and objectives for a supervision training program for IPI.
2. The program will be for training IPI faculty as well as for experienced clinicians looking to expand their practices by providing supervision. Requirements: what are requirements for admission? Fellows; local faculty; national faculty, or any IPI participant?
3. Supervision for psychotherapists using an object relations model; differentiations in child, couple, family and individual work will come later.
4. The program will be competency based; CEU's will be provided to participants.
