

IIPT Steering Committee Minutes
January 20th, 2021

Present: Sue, Colleen, Jane, Karen, Janine, Lea, Michelle, Peter

Minutes: The December minutes were approved.

Summer Institute: The 5 day Summer Institute will be held online. The proposed dates are June 23rd-June 27th, beginning on the 23rd from 5 pm to 8 pm EST. The remaining days will begin at 10 am EST and end time will be determined at a later time. Sunday, June 27th will end at 5 pm EST. Sue and Colleen will coordinate with Lorrie from the Core program regarding dates and times.

Online policy: The IIPT online policy was discussed. Ethical considerations were included.

Candidates: Peter reported that the candidates are doing well. They are particularly enjoying Betty Joseph. All candidates have one case and 2 candidates have 2 cases.

SA Committee: Lea reported that the SA's want to encourage the teaching analysts to co-teach (and the adjuncts) as the SA's feel they are carrying more of the teaching load. The SA's would like more information about the candidate's panels. Lea utilized the writing exercise with a candidate and found it very valuable.

Curriculum Committee: Michelle mentioned that it was difficult to fill all of the teaching slots and there was a discussion about the possible reasons for this. The spring semester schedule is complete, along with objectives. The committee is currently looking at the summer schedule. The feedback from the summer institute was well-received. The committee will add a didactic on the Tuckett or 3LM model in lieu of an additional background reading.

Admissions Committee: Janine has responded to @6 inquiries, mostly through the information section of the IPI website. Typically, Janine offers people who inquire a time to talk but they do not tend to follow through despite Janine's attempts to follow up. From Janine's perspective, there are 3 issues:

1. People are interested but not prepared.
2. People are interested in online training only and lose interest when they are informed of IIPT's in-person requirement.
3. The cost (IIPT's tuition and the cost of supervision).

A few of the inquiries have been international, while most have been from the east coast. Michelle proposed offering an open and free event or case presentation to promote recruitment.

FDC: Nancy was absent; she is working on adjuncts.

CPC: Karen reported that the candidates are all ok so far. Sam's panel is next week. Karen's panel is mid-February. Ryan's is estimated for the end of March. Flora is working on completing requirements.

SA discussion: There was a general discussion about the SA's desire for more communication.
